The Embassy of India in La Paz, organized a yoga event on 15th June, Sunday, in collaboration with the office of the Mayor of Tiwanaku, as part of the 11th International Day of Yoga 2025. The event was held at the Tiwanaku Site Museum, an archaeological site dating back two millenia, recognized by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. Located near the southern shores of Lake Titicaca on the Altiplano, it is at an altitude of 3,850 m.

Ambassador Rohit Vadhwana welcomed all participants at the beginning of the event and thanked Hon'ble Mayor of Tiwanaku Mr. Flavio Eudaldo Merlo Maydana for gracing the event as the Chief Guest.
